The school will:

- Attend Parents' Evenings and meetings about your child's progress.
- Advise the school of any concerns or problems which might affect your child's progress.
- Work constructively and cooperatively with the school to resolve any concerns by supporting school policies and ethos.
- Respect all members of the school community, abiding by their policy of zero tolerance towards rude and aggressive behaviour
