## Other persistent teachings of Personal Development:

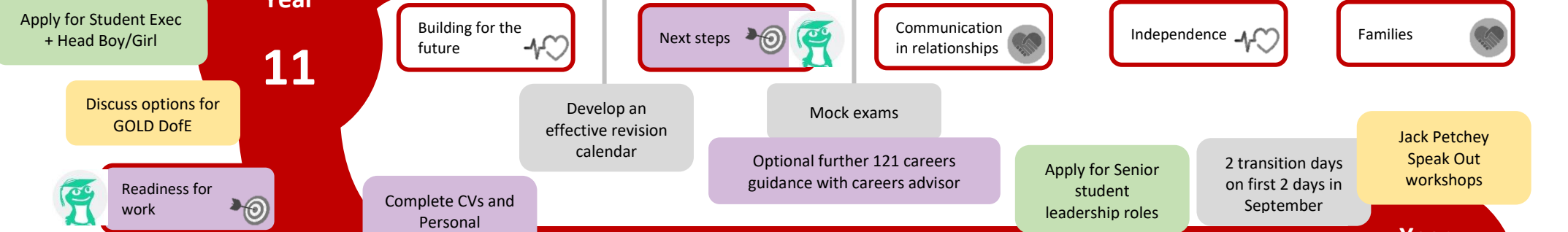
1. Stakeholder surveys calendared throughout each academic year

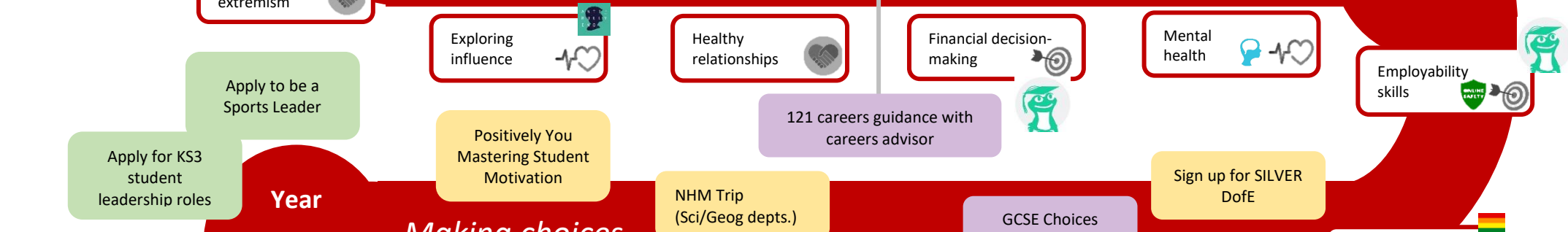

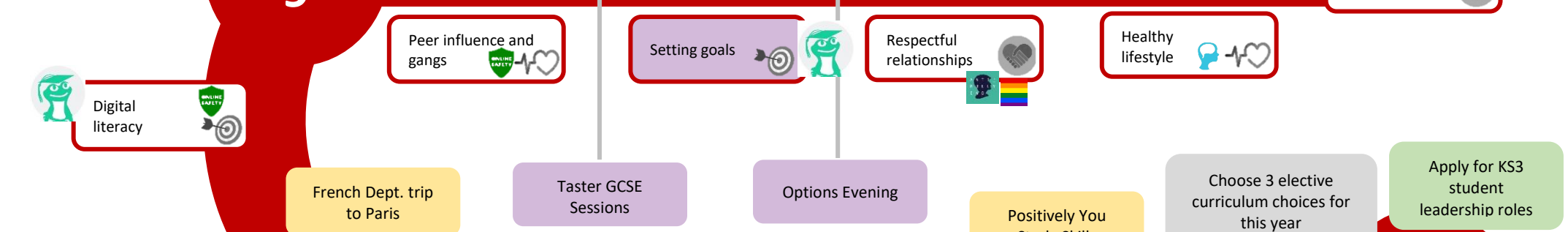

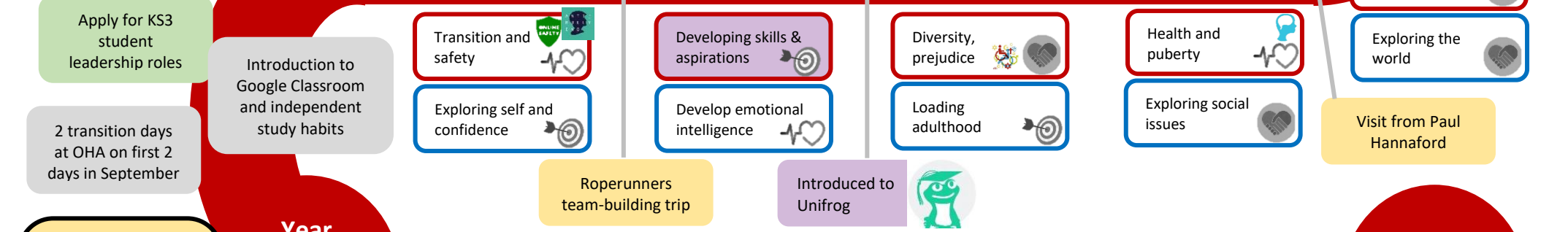
